**TEMPORARY INCAPACITY
(ART.25)**

Temporary work disability (TI), also called **medical leave or work leave**, is the official recognition that a worker who contributes to Social Security cannot do their usual work due to a health problem. It generally entitles them to a financial benefit (subsidy).

We are talking about **two different types of TI**:

- Work accident/Occupational disease
- Non-work accident/Common disease

The financial subsidy may vary depending on the situation or the length of the leave.

In our agreement, all workers in a situation of TI will receive the necessary supplement to reach **100% of their salary during the first three months**. This also includes any salary increases produced during the period of leave.

If you continue in a TI situation beyond the 3 months, you will be compensated at 100% for **one more month for each three years of continued service, up to a maximum of 7 months** in a period of one year.
